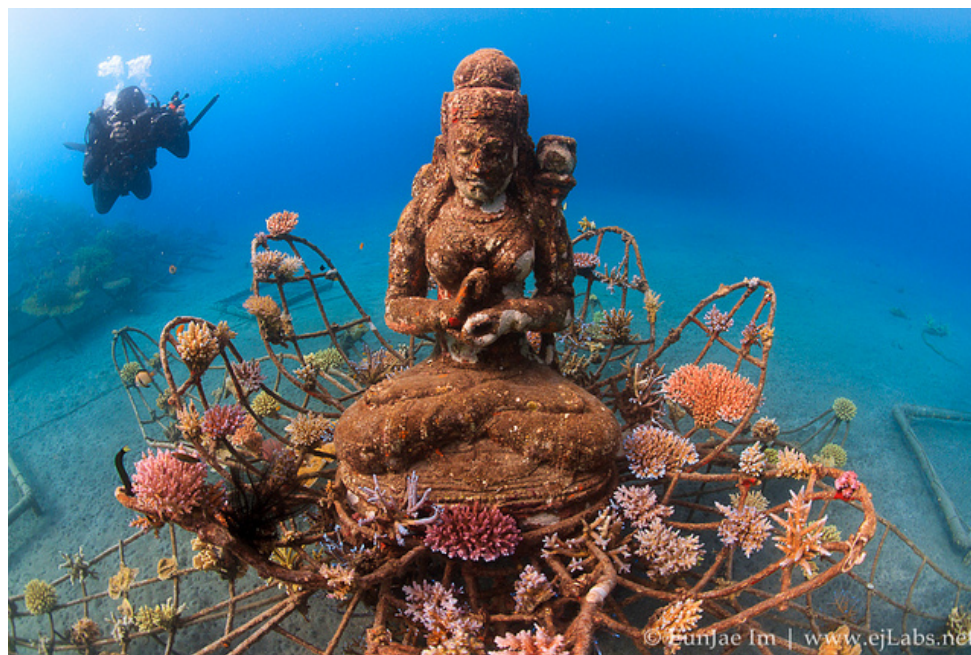

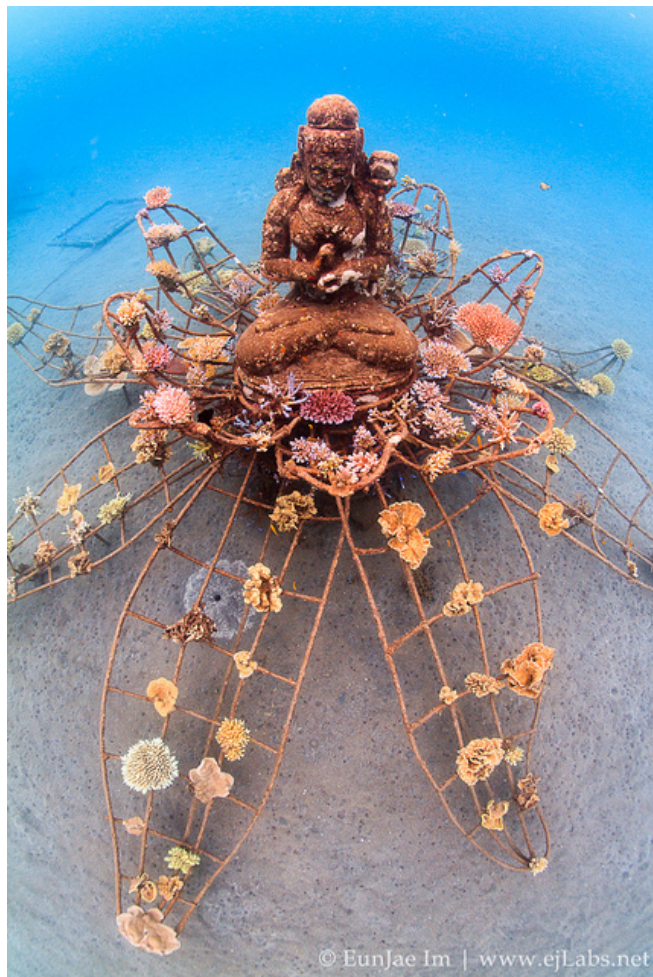
This "The Coral Goddess" sculpture is a beautiful creation by artist, Celia Gregory and her Non-profit: The Marine Foundation.
